## Adventures on the Gorge to Offer Up to 50 Percent Off Winter Lodging

FAYETTEVILLE, W. Va., Oct. 10, 2022 - Southern West Virginia's [Adventures on the Gorge](#) (AOTG) is offering discounts up to 50 percent off for overnight accommodations starting Nov. 1.

Located on 350 acres near Fayetteville, W.Va. overlooking the New River Gorge National Park and Preserve - the nation's newest national park - the resort is popular in winter and spring for romantic getaways and those simply looking for a change of scenery. Because several units are equipped with WiFi, many workers have set up shop and performed their jobs remotely.

"Especially the past two winters, those who want a quiet spot where they can focus on work for part of their day followed by a woodsy hike have discovered us," said Roger Wilson, CEO of AOTG. "I like to say that our cabins are a cure for 'Cabin Fever.'"

AOTG is within an easy drive of many cities in the Midwest, East and South such as Charlotte (four hours), Cincinnati (five hours, 30 minutes) and Washington, D.C. (five hours, 30 minutes).

The area is renowned for its hiking and rock climbing as well as a variety of seasonal activities such as whitewater rafting from spring through fall. This winter AOTG's [TreeTops Canopy Tours](#) will be available to groups of at least four.

The National Park Service [Canyon Rim Visitor Center](#) is close by with interpretive exhibits and videos that tell the story of the gorge's history, wildlife and plant life. The park's Endless Wall hike was voted the best in the national park system, and the New River Gorge Bridge offers great photo opportunities as well as the [Bridge Walk](#) tour. The [African American Heritage Tour](#) is a self-guided auto tour that takes visitors to 17 historic sites in and around the New River Gorge.

Accommodations are discounted through April 30, 2023.  
[Lodging](#) options include:

#### **Sunnyside Suites**

Adjacent to the campground, these cabins feature a deck with wooded views, a kitchenette and luxurious bathroom, all within walking distance to the activities and restaurants. Of the eight units, four feature two queen-sized beds each and four a king-sized bed each. Amenities include desks, Wi-Fi and cable television. Winter rates start at \$114.50.

#### **Sportsman Cabins**

The 24 Sportsman Cabins are one-bedroom, one-bathroom units with three double beds, a full-size futon and either two or four twin beds. Amenities include Wi-Fi air conditioning, efficiency kitchens, picnic table and fire ring. Bedding is provided. Bath and kitchen towels are not provided. Winter rates start at \$109.50.

#### **Kaymoor Cabins and Kaymoor Cabin Suites**

Added to the lineup in 2017, these cabins - seven with two units and six one-bedroom suites - feature king beds, Wi-Fi, desks, step-in showers in the bathrooms and televisions. The suites will also have pull-out sleeper couches in living rooms. Winter rates start at \$89.50.

#### **Outback Cabins**

Outback Cabins are available in one- and two-bedroom configurations. Amenities include full bathrooms, fully equipped kitchens, cable television with DVD player, Wi-Fi, washers and dryers, air conditioning and heat, private decks with hot tubs, picnic tables, fire rings and charcoal grills. Winter rates start at \$159.50.

#### **Deluxe Cabins**

Deluxe Cabins are available with two, three or four bedrooms. Amenities include a fully equipped kitchens, cable television with DVD player, Wi-Fi, washers and dryers, air conditioning and heat, private decks with hot tubs, picnic tables, fire rings and charcoal grills. Winter rates start at \$244.50.
